Construction Management Minor Advising

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- The Construction Management minor is open to undergraduate students who are pursuing a major in business as well as undergraduate students pursuing other majors at DU.
- A minor GPA of 2.00 or higher is required to graduate.
- Only grades of “C-” or higher fulfill minor requirements.
- Any minor course substitutions must be preapproved by the Director of the Burns School.

Construction Management Minor Course Requirements
