- The Finance minor is **only** available to students pursuing a BSBA or BSAcc degree through the Daniels College of Business.
- FIN 3110, FIN 3200, and FIN 3300 typically are taught in fall, winter, and spring quarters.
- A minor GPA of 2.00 or higher is required to graduate.
- Only grades of "C-" or higher fulfill minor requirements.
- Any minor course substitutions must be preapproved by the Director of the Reiman School of Finance.

Finance Minor Course Requirements

Finance is a broad area directed toward the financial elements of business organization and government units, focusing on investment, corporate finance, international finance, and financial institutions and markets.

Prerequisites for any Finance minor class:

- "C-" or better in MATH 1200 Calculus for Business and Social Sciences or MATH 1951 Calculus I
- "C-" or better in ACTG 2200 Introduction to Financial Reporting
- "C-" or better in FIN 2800 Financial Decision Making
