- A minor GPA of 2.00 or higher is required to graduate.
- Only grades of “C-” or higher fulfill minor requirements.
- Any minor course substitutions must be preapproved by the Management Department Chairperson.

### Management Minor Course Requirements

The focus of this minor is on effective management of people – the most important resource in business. Students have the opportunity to study such areas as human resource management, organizational behavior, labor relations, ethics, and organizational communication. The coursework has practical applications for general supervision and management, running a family business, and entrepreneurial endeavors.

#### Prerequisites for any Management minor class:

- “C-” or better in MGMT 2100 Leading High-Performance Organizations (4 credits) – this course is part of the Business Core.

#### Requirements for business majors: 16 credits

*Note:* MGMT 3000 Business Policy and Strategy (4 credits) counts only toward the Business Core requirements and does not fulfill Management minor requirements. Management minors may not count internships or independent study credits toward the minor requirements.
